

What kind of membership is a Junior Associate Club?

Are you already a member of a club or organization? Some examples would be:

- community symphony orchestras
- school choirs, bands, or orchestras
- handbell choirs
- community choral societies
- music teachers' associations
- opera companies
- dance studios
- church choirs, orchestras, or bands
- local alumni chapters of music

An Associate Membership encompasses all age groups formed for the purpose of performance and/or special music projects. The Associate Membership also includes mass enrollment in public, private, or magnet school music programs, including colleges and universities. Associate members are not eligible for participation in NFMC festivals.

Junior members in any Associate organization will be eligible to apply for awards offered in the Junior Division. The WSFMC has always had Junior Associate Clubs. Our current Junior Associate Clubs include:

- Bellevue Youth Symphony Orchestra
- Seattle Youth Symphony Orchestra
- Student Orchestras of Greater Olympia
- Cascade Youth Symphony Orchestras
- Tacoma Youth Symphony Association

All of the Junior-aged members of these organizations are eligible for any Junior Competitions and Awards!
